2019 Annual Conference - Lodging Reservation Information

The Lodging Committee, in behalf of the Brotherhood, is looking forward to our upcoming conference. We pray it will be a season of respite from the cares of this world as we gather to worship our Redeemer and enjoy a season of fellowship that our "hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love..."

These direct and specific questions are necessary to provide accurate lodging and meet Cedarville requirements. Hopefully, this information will also improve and speed up the "check-in process" when you arrive at Annual Conference and pick up your items.

❖ Please read all information before beginning to complete the Reservation Form

SECTION #1

On-Campus Dorm lodging: Dorm buildings at Cedarville are nice, clean, 2 and 3-story brick buildings. Dorm buildings consist of a central lounge with hallways to dorms and restrooms on either side. The lounge area has couches, chairs, and tables for fellowship. Dorm rooms are approx. 11'x17' and consist of two single beds, two dressers, two wardrobes, carpet, heat and a/c. The two single beds are stacked as bunks. You can put as many people in the room as you feel, but 2 adults with 3-4 children will comfortably fill a room.

Rooms **do not** come with bedding and linens. These items can be rented for an extra charge, but we recommend that you bring your own, or get them from brethren or friends. If you plan to put more than two in a room you must bring your own items for floor beds - such as sleeping bags and air mattresses.

Men's and women's bathrooms are located down the hallway, separate from the dorm rooms. Each has several sinks, mirrors, private individual showers, and toilets.

All dorm buildings have coin laundry, although, you will need to bring your own detergents.

Dorm rooms are available Friday night through Tuesday night and you can stay one night or every night, whatever suits you. If you want two or more rooms beside each other we can accommodate this. There are plenty of dorm rooms for everyone.

Special needs: We can accommodate the elderly or the handicapped in ground level rooms.

On-Campus Camper parking: There is a lot on campus that can accommodate motor homes and travel trailers. No hookups are available. There is a sewage dump station at John Bryan State Park for a small fee. Please note there is a separate camper registration form this year.

Motels: There are accommodations in Springfield, Xenia, Beavercreek, and Dayton; all approximately 10 miles away

Campgrounds: There are several facilities in the vicinity; John Bryan State Park and other private campgrounds.

Please read these instructions before beginning to complete the Lodging Reservation Form

Do not use this reservation form if you plan to stay in:

- Your own home
- Brethren's homes You are encouraged to make your own lodging arrangements if you desire to stay in Brethren's homes.
- Motels or campgrounds off-campus. You will be responsible to make your own lodging arrangements if you plan to stay in motels or campgrounds off-campus. The Lodging Committee is happy to answer any questions you may have, however, we do not have any blocks of rooms reserved and do not have a list of available facilities.

Use this reservation form if you plan to stay in:

- Camper parked on-campus
- Dorm room(s) on-campus
- Any combination of the 2 above, such as 1 camper and 1 dorm room
- One of the above for only a portion of the meeting, such as staying on-campus for only 1 night

Bedding & Linens: We are expecting those driving to the conference and staying in the dorms to bring your own bedding and linens from home. We also strongly encourage those who are driving to contact others that are flying and offer to bring bedding & linens for them as well. The reservation form has a place for those staying in dorms to rent bedding & linens. The rental packet includes: 2 flat sheets, 1 blanket, 1 pillow, 1 pillow case, 2 bath towels, 2 wash cloths, 1 hand towel, and 1 bar of soap.

Please notice - This packet is made for one person, so multiple packets may be needed for your room.

Reserving multiple dorm rooms: You may reserve multiple rooms either: 1) located adjacent to each other allowing you to be close to other family members or friends, or 2) multiple rooms without them being adjacent.

- 1) To reserve multiple rooms adjacent to each other Use one form and fill in all the spaces for the additional rooms. These rooms will all be reserved under the person responsible for this reservation listed at the top of the reservation form. When you arrive at Cedarville, ask for the reservation under the "Name of primary occupant in room."
- 2) To reserve multiple rooms that are not adjacent to each other Please use two separate forms. For example, a husband/wife reserves one room for themselves on one form and uses another form to reserve a room for their young folks children to be located near other young folks.

Young Folks: We are trying to make the overnight stay in the dorm rooms at Cedarville a pleasant and enjoyable experience for our young folks and those from other fellowships. Young folk's boys and girls will be placed in separate dorm hallways and will be mixed in with families or at the end of the dorm halls. We encourage parents to be aware of the lodging plans for their children. There will be a Cedarville dorm monitor and a Brethren couple assigned to each dorm, however, they do not wish to serve as chaperones. Cedarville has an 11:00 pm quiet time rule. Young folks less than 18 years old need parental approval to reserve their own room. Young folks wishing to reserve rooms close to other young folks should see above section, "Reserving multiple dorm rooms".

Additional Reservations and Changes: Extra dorm rooms will be available for those deciding to stay on-campus after arriving at the conference. Your registration process will take much longer than if you had completed your reservation ahead of your arrival. We strongly encourage you to make your lodging decision and send your reservation form in by the March 29th deadline. The Lodging Committee wants to be very accommodating while at the same time keeping last-minute reservations and changes to a minimum.

Cancellations: You will be able to receive a credit for your unused nights if your room keys are turned in and the Lodging Committee is aware that your room is empty.

Check-in: When you arrive at Cedarville please proceed to the check-in area in the Stevens Student Center. This will be the main office for the conference and will be staffed on Friday 1:00 pm – 11:00 pm and on Saturday opening at 7:00 am. (Hours will be posted from then on). There you will be given your room keys, camper parking space, maps, directions, dining arrangements, and other information for the meeting.

• We encourage this Information and Reservation Form to be copied and shared with others besides our fellowship who may be interested in attending the conference.
