- **Please do not send payment until you have been notified of acceptance.**
- Campers arrive for registration at **Westbrook Event Center** June 13 at 9:30am; return June 15 at 4pm.
- All campers are to ride the busses to and from canoe trip.
- The \$115 fee includes transportation, lodging, canoe rental and meals.
- There will be volleyball, basketball, gaga ball, canoeing, skits, table activities, singing & worship.
- Pack your bags and bring along a Bible, sleeping bag, pillow, towels, & garbage bag.

Camp Rules:

1. Abide by the curfew rules. **11:30 pm- go to cabins**
12:30 am- in cabins / lights out
2. Stay on the camp grounds at all times.
3. Wear a life jacket during canoeing.
4. Guys and girls stay in their respective cabins.
5. NO fireworks, alcohol, or tobacco
6. Abide by the dress code for the entire canoe trip.
