Come join us for an uplifting and enjoyable time in the High Sierras

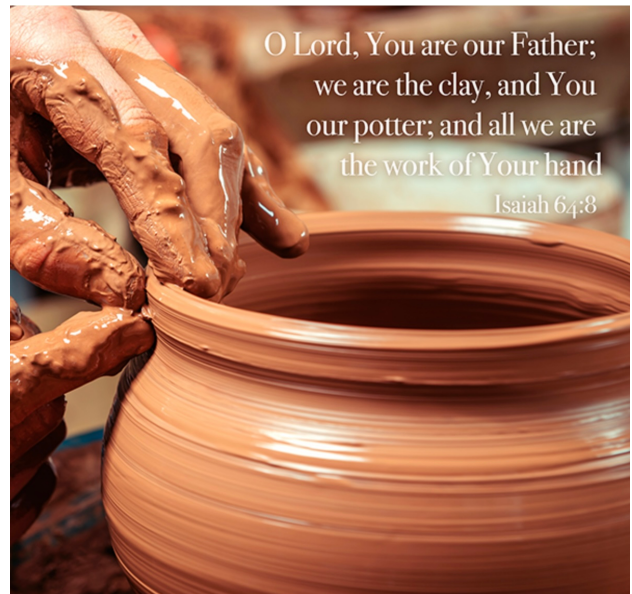
“But now, O LORD, thou art our father; we are the clay, and thou our potter; and we all are the work of thy hand” Isaiah 64:8

We are hosting a New Conference Young-folks camp at Camp Peaceful Pines from July 8-12. Out of state campers must be at least sophomore age or older. New Conference young folks will be given priority and those from other fellowships will be considered on an individual basis as camp capacity permits. We will meet at Brethren Heritage School July 8th at 8:00 a.m. Buses will not wait when it is time to depart. We will return July 12th at approximately 3:00 p.m.

The cost is \$250 per camper; which includes 11 meals, transportation, insurance, camp rental, and a camp picture.

California registration is due by May 4th!!
Out of state registration is due by June 1st.

Due to limited space we cannot guarantee each applicant a spot. However, we will consider each application in the order it was received until Camp is full.

THE CAMPERS CODE

1. Everyone must cooperate and participate in camp duties.
2. Christian conduct and sportsmanship are expected at all times.
3. No unscheduled hikes or parties may leave camp.
4. Boys and girls are not allowed in each others dormitory areas at any time.
5. Girls must wear modest clothing suitable for volleyball and other activities. (skirts should cover knee, no sleeveless tops, no low neck lines).
6. Boys must dress properly and hair must be neat and properly groomed (no sleeveless shirts or shorts)
7. No use of fireworks, matches or tobacco of any kind on the buses or in the camp. Campfires will be lit by authorized persons only.
8. All young people are to be in their own dormitories to stay at 10:00 p.m. Lights out at 10:30 p.m.
9. All campers to return on the bus unless his/her parents specifically give permission to do otherwise.
10. Respect for the rights and wishes of others is to be observed at all times.

These guidelines are intended to promote an enjoyable experience for everyone at camp. We count on and appreciate the cooperation of all campers.

If the Camper's code is violated, the camper will be dealt with in a manner thought most appropriate by the chaperones. If a camper is sent home because of misconduct, the camper or his/her parents will be expected to pay the cost of transportation.
