Reminders & Conference Information

- Do not park in zones marked “No Parking” such as fire lanes, in front of dumpsters, and areas marked with names for year-around residents.
- Dorm doors are not to be blocked open and left unattended.
- Always keep your dorm key fob with you. Your fob will only allow access to the dorm and room you are assigned to.
- Do you need a golf cart ride around campus? Our friendly transportation specialists will be standing by. Please call: **(937)-802-2277**. If it happens to go to voicemail, please hang up and redial. When you call, please provide us with your location so our specialists can rush to your location. There will be plenty of carts so please don't hesitate to call!
- Everyone is to stay away from the lake at all times.
- No one is to be barefooted in the dining area.
- There will be tents outside for stroller parking at the dining location.
- When you see trash on the ground, on the floor of the Sanctuary, or any other building, please take a moment to pick it up and dispose of it.
- The quiet time begins at 11:00 pm. There should be no activity outside the dorm buildings after 11:00 pm.
- It is preferred that we attempt to fill the main floor seats in the Sanctuary before moving up the sides, then onto balcony. Inform your children of this ahead of time.
- We will sing a song or two before each service begins. Please arrive a few minutes early to sing together and prepare our minds for worship.
- All communion volunteers are to meet at 8:15am Sunday morning in room 240/Event Room to go over duties for the communion service.

Cedarville Dorm Information

General Information

1. Each lost room key and dorm admittance key fob will result in a **\$75 fee.**
2. Cedarville will not bunk or debunk any beds. You are responsible for putting beds back as you found them. **If they are not, it will result in a \$30 fee.**
3. Most campus doors lock once the door is closed, be sure to always keep your key with you.
4. Please keep all dorm windows closed, as this will help keep the air- conditioning working properly.
5. There are washers and dryers available in each dorm. **Bring your own detergent.**

Checking out

1. Cedarville charges for each night that the room key and fob are out. If you do not stay for the whole conference, please return your keys promptly.
2. If you leave during the night or after hours, please make arrangements with your Dorm Host for key drop off.
3. Please be checked out 4 hours after Tuesday's meeting or by 10AM Wednesday.
4. **Please empty your room, return beds to their original position and leave the dorm room door propped open.**
5. When checking out please bring room keys, key fobs, and rented linens to the Stevens Student Center. The pillows will not be reused, you may take them with you if you want them. If you do not want to keep the pillows, please include them with the linens you are returning. You do not need to check out with your Dorm Host.

Lodging Information

On-Campus Dorm Lodging:

Availability: Dorm rooms are available **Friday night through Tuesday night.**

Occupancy: 2 adults with 3-4 children comfortably fill a room, but more may be included if necessary.

Beds & Bedding: Each dorm room is equipped with two single beds that may or may not be stacked as bunks. Rooms are 11'x17' in size and cost \$76 per night. **Bring your own linens if not renting a linen packet. For floor beds, please bring what is needed to be comfortable. No mattresses are available.**

Linen Packets: Individual bedding/linen packets are available for \$25.00. **Each packet provides: 2 flat sheets, 1 blanket, 1 pillow, 1 pillowcase, 2 bath towels, 2 wash cloths, 1 hand towel and 1 bar of soap.**

Bathrooms: Designated men's and women's bathrooms with full facilities are in each hall, separate from the dorm rooms. **Bring your own towels and wash cloths if not renting a linen packet.**

Laundry: Coin laundry services are available in all dorm buildings. **Bring your own detergent.**

Special Needs: Ground floor rooms are available for the elderly and those with disabilities.

Young Folks: We look forward to seeing you at Cedarville over Conference this year and hope your stay is enjoyable! **Per Cedarville's requirements, there will be several changes this year. The boys and girls will be placed in separate dorm buildings, and Young Folks who are 17 and younger will not be permitted to share a room with those who are 18 and older.** There will be a dorm host and dorm chaperones assigned to each young folks' dorm. The dorm hosts are not chaperones but will be available to answer questions and maintain accountability. Cedarville has an 11:00 pm quiet time rule. Young folks younger than 18 years old need parental approval to reserve a room. Parents, be informed of your young folks' lodging arrangements and please sign up to chaperone through Sign-up Genius for 3-hour time slots.

Check-in: Stevens Student Center will be staffed on Friday 1:00 pm – 11:00 pm and Saturday at 7:00 am. Hours will be posted from then on. **You must appear in person to pick up your keys. Cedarville will not give your keys to another person in your stead. Cedarville will not distribute keys after midnight. Those arriving after midnight will need to wait until the next morning at 7:00 to check in.**

Cancellations: You will be able to receive reimbursement for any unused nights if your room keys are turned in and the Lodging Committee is notified that your room is empty.

On-Campus RV Parking: Fee is \$50 per camper. No hookups are available. There is a sewage dump station at John Bryan State Park for a small fee. Your camper packet will be available at the check-in area in the Stevens Student Center and will include instructions on the usage of shower/restroom facilities in the West Hall. Parking information can be found on the Transportation Committee's information sheet.

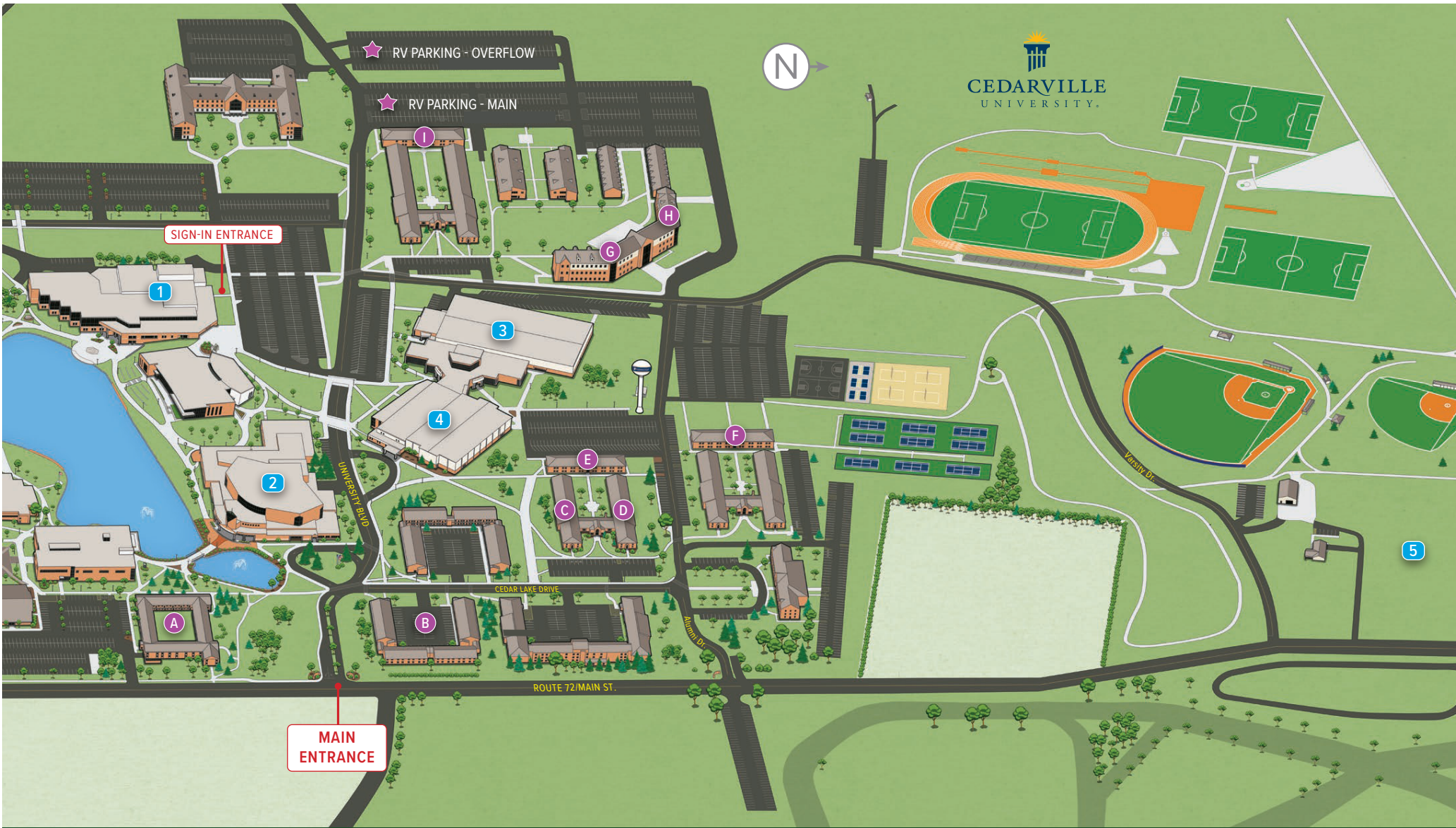

- ✠ Pre-teens are to sign in with a parent/guardian.
- ✠ Child will receive a color-coded wristband that will be turned in at the daily check-out.
- ✠ Parent/guardian will receive a color-coded card with child's name on it & this card MUST be presented at checkout. No exceptions.
- ✠ Pre-teens who request early dismissal must also follow the above mentioned procedure.
- ✠ At check-out pre-teens will be organized by color-coded wristbands in the gym. Parent/guardian will go to the color-coded area to pick up their child. This will happen by returning the color-coded card to the chaperone in charge of that area.
- ✠ **NO PRE-TEENS WILL BE CHECKED IN OR CHECKED OUT WITHOUT A PARENT/GUARDIAN.**
- ✠ If a situation occurs where the parent can't check-out their child, they MUST give the child's color-coded card to the responsible party who will check out their child.

Additional Guidelines:

- ✠ Pre-teens need to wear gym shoes that are clean, dry, and non-marking in respect of the gym floor.
- ✠ Pre-teens are encouraged to dress modestly and be kind and courteous while interacting with each other.
- ✠ Rip Sticks, rollerblades, roller skates, skateboards, foot scooters, bicycles, etc. are not permitted to be used on the conference site.

To the Parents of Pre-teens:

- ✠ Our desire is to provide a safe and godly atmosphere for your children. You and your pre-teens are welcome anytime during pre-teen activities.
- ✠ Pre-teens is only open during the times listed on the conference schedule.
