Please bring the following items:

***Faith & Praise songbook with your name in it.**

***Sleeping bag/pillow**

***Comfy shoes for hiking & for volleyball (one court has more rocks, while not mandatory, you might want to bring gym shoes)**

***Your own reusable water bottle with you name on it- this will be used during sporting events to stay hydrated! We will not have paper cups in the sports area. This has worked very well in the years past!**

CAMP UTMOST GUIDELINES:

- **Food & Wildlife Safety:** Please do not bring food into cabins, as it may attract animals. Bears have a particular fondness for Sour Patch Kids!
- **Modest Attire:** We kindly ask that girls wear modest clothing, especially for activities like volleyball. Sleeveless tops, low necklines, and skirts above the knee are not permitted. Please no earrings. Boys should also refrain from wearing sleeveless shirts.. Thank you for your cooperation in dressing respectfully.
- **Cabin Arrangements:** Male and female cabins are designated separately and should remain closed to the opposite gender at all times. **NO GUYS IN GIRLS AREA AND NO GIRLS IN GUYS AREA.**
- **Campers are to stay in their own cabin during sleeping hours.**
- **Campfires:** Only designated individuals, as assigned by Camp Utmost, may start campfires.
- **Curfew:** Campers should be in their cabins by 10:30 PM. Heaters are available in cabins if needed, depending on the weather.
- **Hiking Safety:** Hikes must be scheduled through the activities team. Unscheduled hikes or leaving camp on your own are not allowed.
- **No alcohol, tobacco, vaping or illegal drug use. Fireworks, firearms, and knives are not permitted at camp. No foul language or inappropriate talk.**
- **Mealtime Responsibilities:** Campers will take turns assisting in the kitchen and cleaning the dining area after meals. Singing while you work is always encouraged!
