Lodging Information

On-Campus Dorm Lodging:

Rooms: Dorm rooms are available Friday night, June 5th, check-in starting at 2pm, through Tuesday night, June 9th, check-out by 10AM Wednesday morning, June 10th.

Please assist friends and family who may be unfamiliar with this process. For cancellations or refunds, see below.

Occupancy: Each room varies, but keep in mind, according to Fire Code, there may only be 1 additional person per room, other than the allotted beds. (example: 2 beds, 3 people allowed) Parents are welcome to have multiple small children sleeping on the floor. Air mattresses are available for families if needed. Door shall not be propped open at any time.

Linen Packets / Air Mattress: Individual bedding /linen packets are available for \$27. Packets include: 1 flat sheet, 1 fitted sheet, 1 pillowcase, 1 pillow, 1 light blanket, 2 bath towels, 1 hand towel, 1 washcloth. Please reserve linens and air mattresses during online registration, limited quantities available. If you are not flying, kindly consider bringing your own linens and mattresses. Reserved linens and mattresses will be placed inside your room. Linens and mattresses may be purchased upon check-in, as supplies last.

Bathrooms: Bathrooms are adjacent to each room or pair of rooms. Please bring your own soap, towels and washcloths if you do not purchase a linen packet.

Laundry: Each Residence Hall has free laundry. Please bring your own laundry soap.

Special Needs: Please let us know on your registration if you have special needs. Ground floor rooms are available for the elderly and those with disabilities. We will try to accommodate the needs with the resources available.

YFs Lodging: We look forward to seeing you! Single young men and single young ladies will be lodging in separate resident halls. Please Note & Respect the Quiet Time Policy from 11 pm to 7 am. YF must be inside each resident hall by 12PM and within their room by 12:30AM. Door shall not be propped open at any time. YF Boys and Girls shall not enter the others' dorm halls. Parents, please be informed of your YFs' lodging arrangements.

YFs Check-In:

Check in for the YFs will be in the lobby of each gender's Residence Hall from 2-8pm on Friday. YF must check-in before going to YFs. If you arrive later, please ask for the YF dorm hosts for assistance. Each YF individual must check-in. YF may not pick up keys for others.

Check-Out:

The key drop box located in the southeast foyer of the Barnes Student Center. Upon leaving your room, please make sure your room is clean, all trash is bagged and placed in the trash cans on each floor, all furniture is returned to original position, and the door is left open and unlocked. Check out on Tuesday is 6pm and check out on Wednesday is 10am. If you have special needs for check-out, please visit the Lodging Desk or contact via the number below. Camper Information

On-Campus Camper Parking:

Accommodations: \$28 per camper/night. No hookups are available. Limited water service available upon request via mobile tanker.

Arrival Directions: Help us honor IWU's request that there be NO RV's on any campus streets other than 45th Street. All campers are to enter campus on 45th Street ONLY. Arrive from the South, either from South Washington St on the West side of campus or Adam St (SR-15) on the East side of campus. Please follow these instructions. Do not go by your GPS.

Campers arriving from the North/East

SR-15 & SR-9 After they connect on NW corner of Marion, continue S to Jct of SR-9, SR-37 and S. Washington St. Make a SHARP left onto S. Washington St. heading NE to 45th St., turn right (East) to lot on left (North).

I-69 ~ Go West on SR-18 through Marion to Jct SR-15 & SR-9, turn left (South). Follow above directions after you turn left (South).

Campers arriving from the East/Southeast.

From I-69, go West on SR-22/US-35 through Gas City to Jct of SR-15N. Turn right (North) to 45th St. Turn left to lot on right.

Campers arriving from the South.

SR-37/SR-9 Go North to Jct with South Washington St...Do not turn... Continue NE on South Washington St to 45th St. Turn right (East) to lot on left (North).

Campers arriving from the West on SR-22/US-35 to Jct with SR-37, turn left (North) to Jct with SR-9 and South Washington St...Do not turn...continue NE to 45th St., turn right (East) to lot on left (North)

Campers arriving from the West on SR-18 Come to Jct SR-15/SR-9, turn right (South) to Jct of SR-37/SR-9 and South Washington St. Make SHARP left turn on South Washington St. heading NE to 45th St. Turn right (East) to lot on left (North).

Camper Check-In: Camper host on staff will instruct where to park. Upon parking, please find the camper liaison for check-in of the camper and associated registrants.

Camper Parking: All campers wanting to park next to each other MUST arrive together! Campers will be directed to parking spots by the Camper Host on staff.

Camper Showers: There are 2 sets of locker rooms open to the public for showering in the Recreation & Wellness Center (RWC). Use the main doors on the west side of the RWC to access the Main/Central Locker Rooms 149 (women) and 151 (men). Secondly the Pool Locker Rooms 105 (men) and 107 (women). Guests should seek to use the Main/Central Locker Rooms first and the Pool Locker Rooms as overflow.

CAM has sent the most hygiene kits to Yemen and Ukraine. Yemen received around 50,000 last year and Ukraine 14,000.

Why are hygiene kits needed?

To help prevent the spread of disease

If people are not able to afford basic hygiene items, preventable diseases are easily spread and can cause people to become sick.

To help give personal dignity

In times of crises, sometimes people are stripped of the ability to maintain personal hygiene and cleanliness.

To help those in vulnerable conditions

In some countries, children, the elderly, and those with compromised immune systems are especially susceptible to sickness.
